"Playing Up" Permit

The clubs policy is that all players should play in their appropriate age group as determined by the F&DJFL age policy.

Permission to play in an older age group can be granted in the following circumstances but only where the player is not deemed to be at unacceptably greater risk of injury due to the age difference.

Exceptions to this policy are:

- On a casual, week by week, basis a player may be permitted to play for an older age team (limited to one year older) subject to the agreement of the coaches of both teams and the players' parent(s) or guardian(s). No "Playing Up" permit is required in this situation. **The player must not be at unacceptably greater risk of injury due to the age difference.**
- On a season basis, where in the opinion of the coaching coordinator a player meets all the following criteria, a player may be permitted to play for an older age team (limited to one year older):
 - The player is not at unacceptably greater risk of injury due to the age difference.
 - The older age team must have a demonstrated shortage of players.
 - The player should have some demonstrated history with the players of the older team.
- Upon successful granting of this permit, it is valid for the current season only and it can be withdrawn during the season.
